

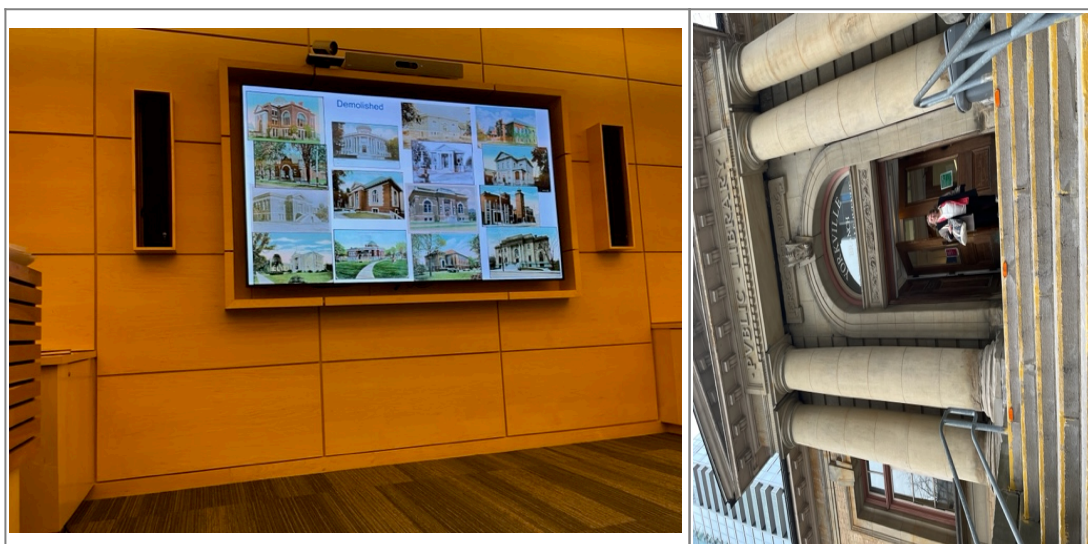
Ex Libris Tours

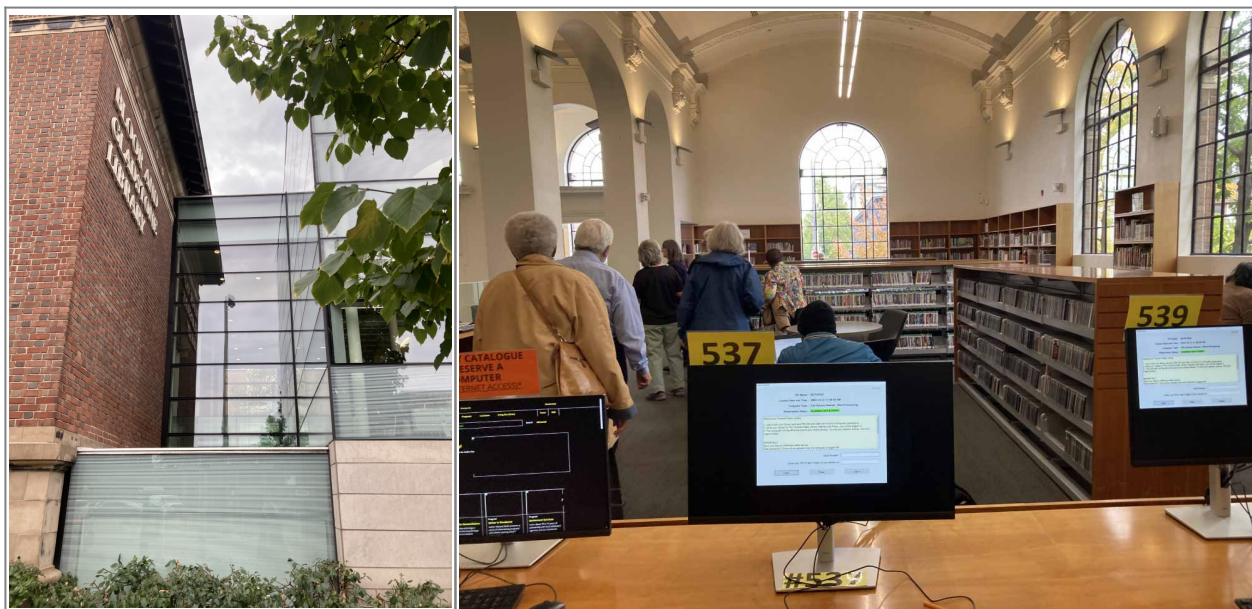
